Penn State University Press proposal guide for prospective series authors

## Proposal:

In 3 to 5 pages, please explore the following. Please also include a CV and a sample chapter, if possible.

- What is the book about?
- Why is it important? What contributions will it make to the field? What is innovative?
- Clarify scope and focus
- Discuss audience and market
- Discuss fit with the series
- Provide an annotated table of contents
- Provide a brief discussion of your credentials
- Provide a timetable for completion

If your proposed manuscript is a revised dissertation:

- When was it defended?
- Be clear about where you are in the revision process
- Discuss what revisions you've made and/or outline your revision plan
- Is the dissertation available online? Has it been embargoed?

If your proposed manuscript is an edited collection:

- Discuss the origins of the project
- How will the essays be organized?
- What makes this collection cohesive?

## Manuscript:

- House style: Chicago Manual of Style, full bibliography and short style citations throughout
- Goal length: Fewer than 85,000 words, including notes and bibliography
- Be cognizant of copyright status or fair use for any images, or long excerpts of previously published material you wish to include
